

## Terms and conditions

This Competition is open to residents of the Mainland UK, aged 18 years or over for the adults competition and 18 and under for the young people's competition, except for employees of LDN Photography and members of the Eye on Streatham and Streatham Festival Committee, their families or anyone else associated with this competition.

2. All information detailing how to enter this Competition forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the competitor agrees to abide by these rules. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.

3. How to enter the competition. Entries will be accepted via images posted to the Eye on Streatham Facebook group in the competition albums, images posted on Instagram that have the hashtag **#eyeonstreatham** and the tag **@eyeonstreatham**. Entries could also be accepted via email at: **eyeonstreatham@gmail.com**. Images submitted via email should be less than 3mb and between 1000 and 3000 pixels on their longest edge. We regret that we are unable to accept postal entries.

4. All entries must be received by the advertised closing time and date. Due to social media rules and restrictions, any images that do not pass basic permissions of Facebook or Instagram including nudity will not be accepted into the competition.

5. All images submitted must be the work of the individual submitting them and must not have won a prize in any other photographic competition. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit which include an identifiable person or persons have been taken with the permission of the person or persons pictured and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws. Entrants must warrant that the photograph they are submitting is their own work and that they own the copyright for it.

6. Copyright for all images submitted for this Competition remains with the respective entrants. However, in consideration of their providing the Competition, each entrant grants a worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual licence to the Streatham Festival to display, print or use your images to promote the Streatham Festival and Eye on Streatham. Full credit to the photographer will be used at all times.

7. Illegible, incomplete, defaced or corrupt entries will not be accepted. No responsibility can be accepted for lost entries and proof of transmission will not be accepted as proof of receipt. Entries must not be sent through agencies or third parties.

8. Criteria for a winning entry will be: It has been judged to be most visually appealing, original and self-explanatory. The winner will be notified within seven days of the closing date of the competition. Images will be judged by the Eye of Streatham judging panel.

9. Prizes will be awarded for each category (**Autumnal Streatham; Portraits (Pets, Family, People); Nature in Streatham; Streatham Street Photography**). A category winning entry will receive an A4 print and the overall winning entry for the adult prize will receive a framed A3 print, the overall winning entry for the young persons (under 18) prize will receive a framed A3 print.

10. The prizes as described are available on the date of publication. All prizes are non-transferable and there are no cash alternatives.

11. Events may occur that render the Competition itself or the awarding of the prizes impossible due to reasons beyond the control of the Promoter and accordingly the Promoter may at its absolute discretion vary or amend the Competition and the entrant agrees that no liability shall attach to the Promoter as a result thereof.

12. English law applies and the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts shall prevail. Promoter: Streatham Festival, Eye on Streatham.

13. Pictures must have been taken between 8 August 2020 (the launch of the first workshop for Eye on Streatham) and the closing date of 31 October 2020.
