Main character (MC) finds a magical portal and enters.	Lucy is playing hide and seek with her siblings. She discovers the wardrobe in the Spare Room.	
Describe the new setting	Description of a winter forest scene. <i>'something cold and soft was falling on her... standing in the middle of a wood at night-time with snow under her feet and snowflakes falling through the air... dark tree-trunks'</i>	
The main character meets a friendly character and finds out more information about the new world.	Lucy meets Mr Tumnus the Faun and is invited to have tea in his cave. <i>'she heard a pitter patter of feet...a very strange person stepped out from among the trees... He had wonderful tales to tell of life in the forest... the midnight dances...long hunting parties after the milk-white stag.'</i>	
The MC encounters trouble in the new world. Threatened by someone/ something.	The White Witch keeps Narnia in an eternal winter with no Christmas. She wants any Sons of Adam or Daughters of Eve to be brought to her. The inhabitants of Narnia live in fear- she may turn them to stone if they disobey her!	
The MC has to escape and return through the portal.	The Witch's spell is broken and Narnia is returned to a world of life and colour, with the help of Lucy. She re-enters the wardrobe through the trees surrounding the lamppost.	
The MC has returned to their own land & makes a final comment on the adventure.	<i>'It was the same day and the same hour of the day on which they had all gone into the wardrobe to hide.'</i>
